FAVORITE MOVIES REVIEW

Today I review the cult classic "**Plan Nine From Outer Space**" which was writer/director/producer Edward D. Wood Jr.'s "Citizen Kane" if you will. This film has gained fame, having been touted as "the worst movie ever made". Will it live up to this high standard?

All seems well in Los Angeles until those darned aliens return for the ninth time with their aptly named "Plan Nine" to conquer the Earth. It is no wonder that the first eight plans failed, as the aliens claim to be of a much higher intellect than humans, but one can't help but wonder how they managed to make flying saucers without throwing plates around in the sky. Plan Nine uses "advanced" technology to revive the dead of Earth and enslave them to take over their own former planet.

One simply cannot describe all of the things wrong with this movie. In the frequently used graveyard set, tombstones wobble with every step, characters seem lost in the hokey mist, and, in one of the funniest scenes of the movie, one of the dead who is supposed to rise (a former pro wrestler) gets stuck in the burial pit and obviously needed a push to get out. The cockpit scene (made with two chairs, airplane noises, and a curtain) is hilarious, as the "hero" of the story pairs his bad acting with perhaps the worst dialogue ever (excluding Silver hair songs). One may not think that a 79 minute movie can carry on with such incessant apathy, but "Plan Nine" delivers from start to finish.

This movie is, in fact, so bad that a recent movie starring Johnny Depp was made recently to commemorate Ed Wood's crowning achievement (Plan Nine). The only "drawbacks" from this otherwise perfectly terrible movie are that it is in black and white and that the climax is not sufficiently pitiful. If you can appreciate the art of being utterly pathetic, this is the perfect movie for you. Incidentally, should you wish to see this movie, contact the editor.

"Plan Nine from Outer Space" receives **0 out of 10** possible points. I actually think it would be more enjoyable to watch this than a five star movie, though.

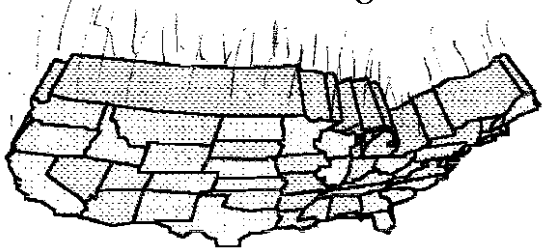

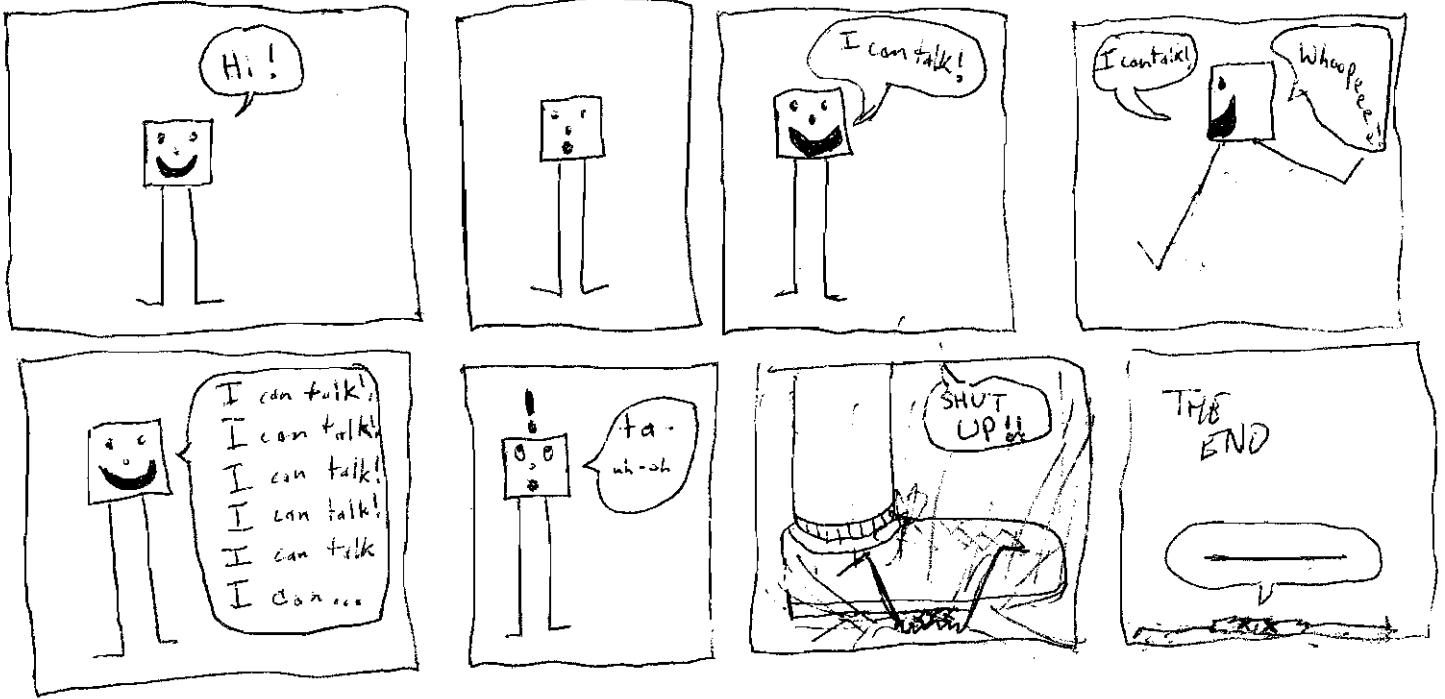

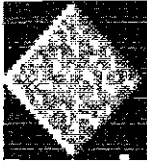
Heitzinger Teams with Vader to Demonstrate "How a Smoker Breathes"

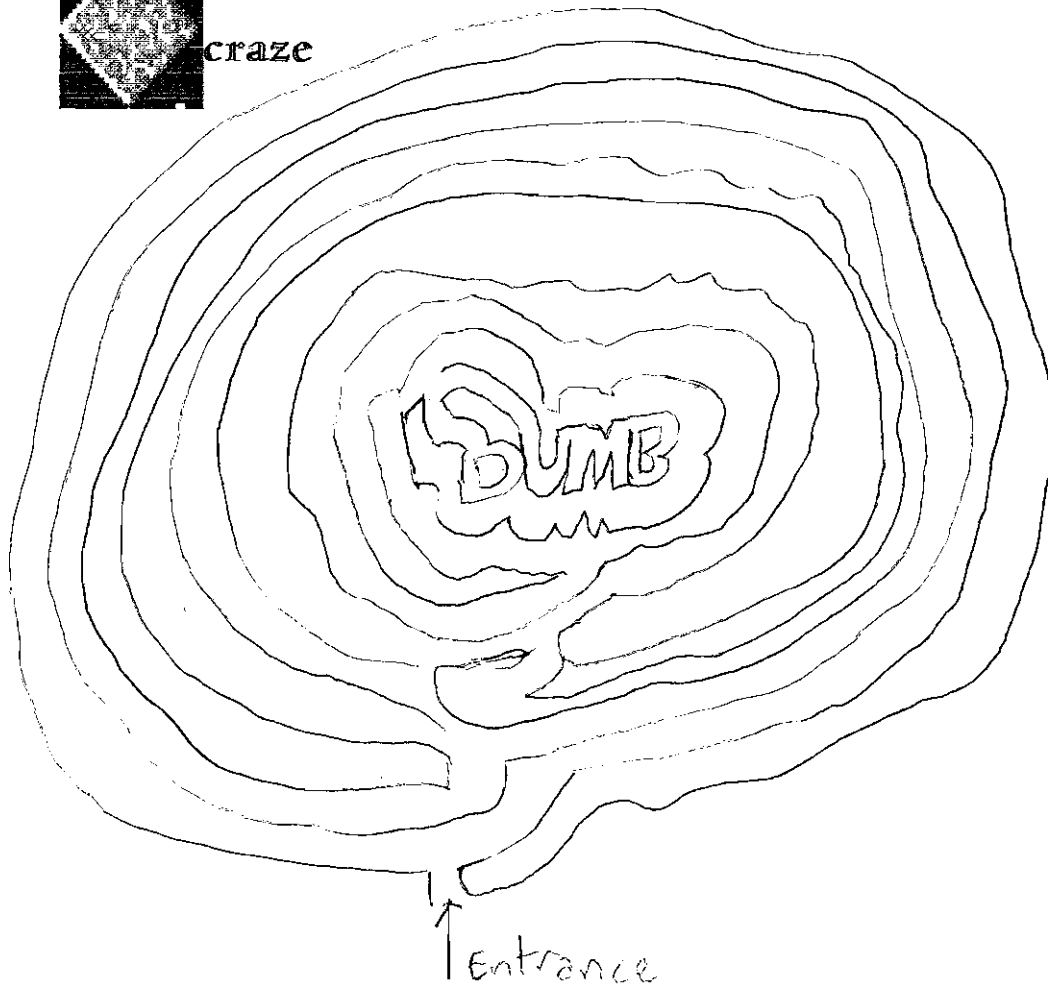
