FAVORITE MOVIES REVIEW

Today, I will review a movie which actually /sone of my favorites. This movie is **Time Bandits**, directed by Terry Gilliam of Monty Python fame. The film stars Sean Connery, John Cleese, Shelley Duvall, Michael Palin and others as well. It's star-studded cast really does more of cameo appearances, though. The main characters are all people whom you have never heard of, but the acting is actually surprisingly good.

The story revolves around a nearly obnoxious English boy who lives in Suburbia with his stereotypical suburban parents who watch TV all day. The kid dreams that a medieval knight breaks through his closet and rides through the wall into the forest. This being an unusual occurrence, the boy brings a flashlight to bed with him and stays up late the next night to see what happens. Following a moment of darkness, a mischievous brigade of midgets appears from within his closet. They are the time bandits. They have stolen a map from the supreme being which shows all of the "time holes" (mistakes in creation, which can lead to any time and place). Joining the boy, they use this map to the richest people in history and rob them. This all works out fine until Evil intervenes, hoping to take the map for himself and show the supreme being what a waste of time it was to create slugs. During their journeys, they rob Napoleon (only to have their loot taken by Robin Hood), they visit Winston the Ogre in the Time of Legends, and pay a visit to the Fortress of Ultimate Darkness in search of the most fabulous object in the world (which turns out to be a trap set by evil).

If you can look by the old filmwork, the annoying voice of the boy, and a few slow spots, Time Bandits is a darn good movie. Evil is especially amusing throughout the film. Michael Palin is very good as a man with a problem. This is an all-around fine blend of science fiction, action, and comedy. If you enjoy ancient history class (or if you paid attention in it), the historical references are quite hilarious. If not, there is enough other stuff to keep your interest, namely the little people running around hitting each other. This highly unusual movie receives **8.5 of 10** possible points and deserves every one of them. As promised, the rating scale for good movies is included.

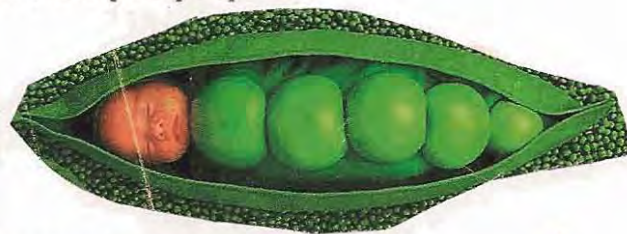

It accomplishes what it means to do in a strong and entertaining way. 8- Excellent movie. Big time movies don't get much higher than this. Was the Bearded Lady a Genetic Freak- or the Victim of a Contagious Disease?

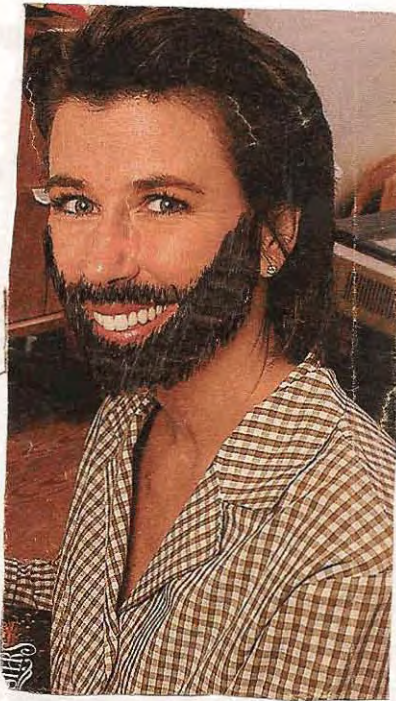

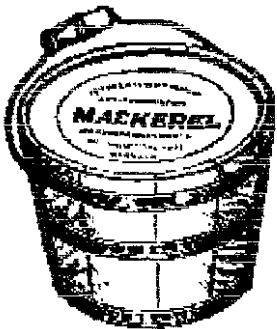
