Area Student to Make It a Great Day...

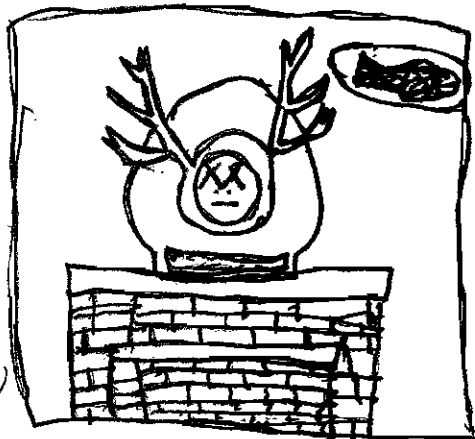
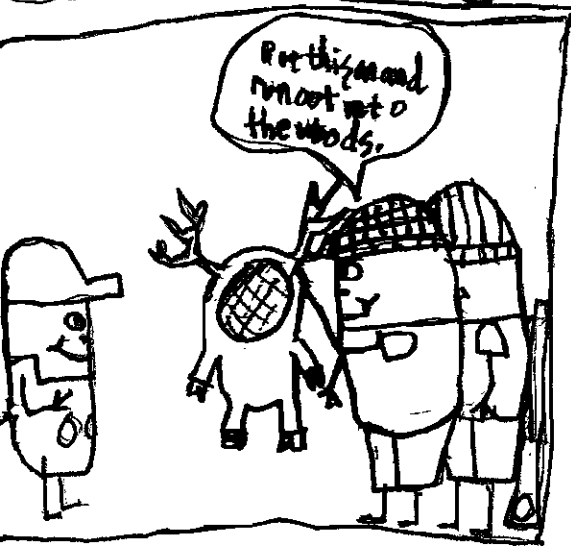
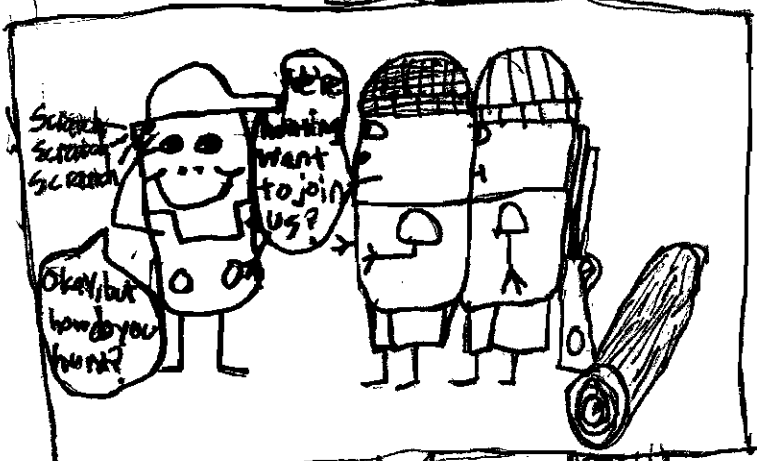
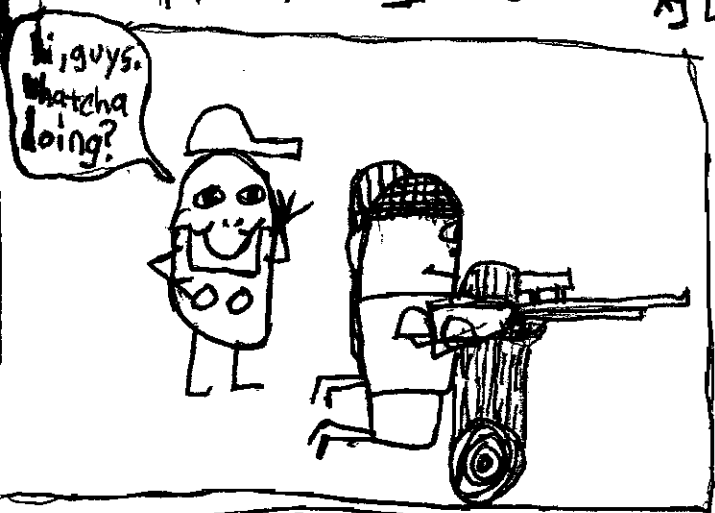

### SMACK Racket Put Down... Badminton Player Jokes: "I Put the SMACK Down!"

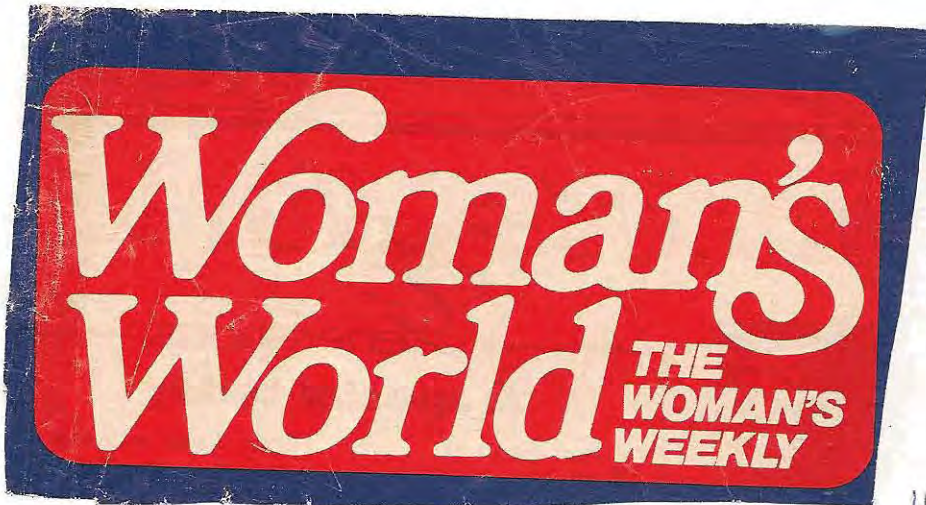

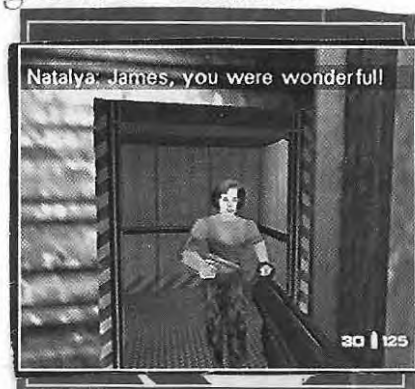
You have many weapons at your disposal in this game like Bonds choice of weaponry the Silenced PP7.
